In the fall of 1999, Bleu Provence was born.

The namesake of the restaurant pays homage to where the couple met, and their mutual love of the sky, the sea, and the fields of lavender in Provence. Bringing the south of France to the south of Florida, Bleu Provence started off as a small 16-table restaurant. This dynamic duo's newest venture was a natural pairing of Jacques' passion for fine wines and Lysielle's love of French cuisine and the culinary arts.

Over the years, Bleu Provence has gone through several major renovations, vastly increasing its original size. Today, Bleu Provence houses a Wine Spectator Grand Award-winning wine collection of over 4,850 varietals and 49,000 bottles located in The Cave, and a retail wine store, Bleu Provence Fine Wines, featuring over 2,500 varietals available at discounted rates. In the restaurant, there are three main dining areas including a beautiful outdoor garden, The Crayton Room overlooking Crayton Cove, and a view of the kitchen from the main dining room. For more intimate occasions, guests may reserve the Wine Room for private parties and events.

When Jacques and Lysielle are not busy making continuous improvements to Bleu Provence, the couple can be found spending quality time with their grandchildren. Particularly passionate about children's causes, the couple actively supports many organizations in the local community and has been a supporter of The Naples Children & Education Foundation via the Naples Winter Wine Festival since its inception in 2001. In 2022, Bleu was especially honored to be a part of the record-breaking top lot, "A Million Dollar Meal – All for the Kids."
